The Partnership Division

orchestrates community and outreach initiatives that are geared towards empowering individuals to adeptly and securely harness an extensive range of technologies and resources to navigate the digital landscape confidently and safely.





The e-Learning Division over

the last decade has driven the organization's mandate to create and facilitate an enabling and progressive ICT culture through enhancing and expanding ICT education, training, and awareness across Sri Lanka.

From April 2018 - March 2023,

the two divisions have engaged with many policymakers, corporate leaders, educators, parents, school children, and the public at large.



Since pioneering domain name registration in Sri Lanka over three decades ago, the LK Domain Registry is hailed today as a pivotal entity in the country's progressive and dynamic IT landscape. The Registry is particularly instrumental in administering the country code top-level domain (ccTLD) ".lk".

Established in 1990 as an independent national entity providing professional domain registration services, LK Domain Registry is the sole administrator of the top-level ".lk" domain. Engaged in developing progressive domain policies and at the forefront of implementing rapidly evolving technologies, the ".lk" domain ensures a credible national identity for a plethora of Sri Lankan organizations aiming to establish their presence across the globe.

LK Domain Registry is dedicated to ensuring Sri Lanka continues to be at the forefront of Domain Name System (DNS) infrastructure, technology, and expertise. History

Established in 2009, the Training Division has conducted a number of initiatives under the able guidance of an expert team of industry veterans, with the far-reaching aim of ensuring equitable access to transformational technology, knowledge, and tools in order to ensure nationwide growth and development of ICT.

The training initiatives, which include island-wide Train the Trainer (TOT) programmes, have over the years trained countless educators and students in schools and vocational training centers across the country.

The training sessions focus on hands-on experience in addition to theoretical knowledge, encouraging experimentation and innovation with a view toward nurturing the next generation of ICT trailblazers.

A series of training workshops (IT Yahamaga) was conducted by Sarvodaya-Fusion in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and facilitated by LK Domain Registry to ignite curiosity and passion and prepare the next generation of youth to take the reins of the future of ICT in Sri Lanka.

Targeting educators and students in semi-urban and rural communities, with over 25,000 students trained from 2018-2020, the project facilitated access to state-of-the-art technology, training, and resources, in order to expand youth horizons and introduce them to the world of opportunities made accessible through ICT.





Statistics for the past 5 years through Direct Delivery training April 2018 to March 2023




Training through Nenasala Centers and Web Competitions

The Nenasala Centre programme is conducted with the aim of disseminating training and skills development with greater efficiency and reaches throughout Sri Lanka. Under this training model, the LK Domain Registry Training Division conducted train the trainer programmes on Joomla Web Design and Python for Nenasala personnel, at the LK Domain Registry premises as well as online.



Web Competitions were conducted in 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022 among students trained to display their newly acquired web design skills, attracting great interest and a significant number of applications. Subsequently, award ceremonies were held and prizes were given to the winners.

Cyber Lowata Piyapath ENSURING AN EQUAL PLATFORM FOR GLOBAL EDUCATION FOR ALL.



Phase 1

Development of official websites for every school in Sri Lanka. LK Domain Registry played a pivotal role by funding the project and training Webcomms global trainers, who in turn conducted workshops for individual schools, training and guiding students to collaboratively design and develop a website for their school.

As of March 31, 2023, a total of nearly 700 websites were completed and handed over to many educational zones throughout Sri Lanka.

Phase 2

To build the leading and highest quality national e-learning platform "Student Assessment System" that will act as a catalyst for knowledge sharing and development. As a pilot initiative, we are in the process of creating activities and assessment tests aligned with the Grade 6 Mathematics syllabus of the National Curriculum with the contributions of experienced teachers and educators as well as mentors. As schools across the country shut down and millions of children were deprived of education at the outset of the pandemic, timely intervention in the form of a joint collaboration between the Ministry of Education, LK Domain Registry, and WEBCOMMS Global (Pvt) Ltd., enabled the development and implementation of an agile ICT framework to mobilise and support learning continuity across Sri Lanka's school system.

to enhance the knowledge of the technical staff of the member organisations, providing information and hands-on experience via a simulated attack scenario, focused on managing cyber-attacks targeting a domain registry system.





ICT HISTORY IN SRI LANKA

The History of ICT in Sri Lanka' is a project conceived by LK Domain Registry with the objective of documenting for posterity the milestones reached by inspirational individuals, their tireless efforts, and momentous events that contributed towards the implementation of ICT in Sri Lanka.

The innovation and dedication that laid the foundation for this revolution hail back to the early 1960s. A history spanning five decades is described through videos of these pioneers and write-ups sprinkled with personal reflections, nostalgic memories, and rare insights into the history of ICT in Sri Lanka. Documents supplied by interviewees, a gallery of photographs and updates add to the site's informational and research appeal.



Books published under this initiative

"How ICT was enabled in Local Languages" written by Aruni Goonetilleke

The book covers the initiatives made from the 1970s up to 2020, by state sector organisations such as the Council for Information Technology (CINTEC), its successor ICTA, the University of Colombo School of Computing (UCSC), the University of Moratuwa, the Sri Lanka Standards Institution and the Natural Resources, Energy and Science Authority of Sri Lanka (NARESA), etc., and by private sector organisations

and by individuals. Aruni made every effort to find and interview specific individuals who worked in the areas of ICT and local languages. There individuals were consulted to ascertain the work they did in enabling the use of ICT in Sinhala and Tamil and the outcome was comprehensively recorded and included in the book. Documents collected and knowledge acquired by Aruni while working on this area at CINTEC and at ICTA were extensively used. Numerous individuals generously contributed interesting photographs, all of which have been included in the book. The book is presented in an easily readable style, with a visually pleasing and attractive design for both the cover and its contents.

The book was launched in July 2020 by the LK Domain Registry.





This book is a historical record of the way in which the Government sector entered the ICT The Computer and Information arena. Technology Council of Sri Lanka (CINTEC), the first Government apex body on ICT, was established in 1984. The drafting of the very first National Computer Policy in Sri Lanka, the enactment of the Computer and Information Technology Act No 10 of 1984 through which CINTEC was set up, operational planning and implementation, overcoming the initial impediments and the work that CINTEC carried for nearly 20 years until its closure in 2003 are aptly described in this book.

The book was launched in March 2023 by the LK Domain Registry.

Hithawathi (Your Confidante) is a social empowerment initiative of LK Domain Registry that aims to promote cyber safety in Sri Lanka, with a particular focus on females and children.

Revamped in 2019, the project today hosts comprehensive features such as a website, email, telephone hotlines, etc., offering a range of support, guidance, and counseling services through an integrated network of multiple channels and platforms.

V.K. SAMARANAYAKE GRANTS SCHEME

Named after Professor V.K. Samaranyake, a renowned pioneer in the IT industry in Sri Lanka, the grants scheme aims to facilitate and enhance research, training, and development capabilities and opportunities at both national and international levels, in Networking and Communication related to the IT industry. Primary beneficiaries of the grants are full-time post-graduate students at MSc, MPhil, and PhD levels in recognised universities and institutes in Sri Lanka.

While contributing to the overall development of Sri Lanka's professional competency framework, the grants also contribute towards the career development aspirations of the recipients, offering opportunities to gain more exposure and experience, while encouraging recipients to invest in their professional development in Sri Lanka, rather than seeking permanent avenues overseas.
